



What are Service Standards?

The purpose of **Service Standards** are to achieve the following goals:

- Establish criteria and processes for evaluating existing services and planning changes to the transit system
- 2. Adopt a more equitable and fiscally responsible approach to maximize service effectiveness
- 3. Ensure that MARTA provides transit services in compliance with Federal and State mandates (MARTA Act, Title VI, LEP, seniors, etc.)







Service Evaluation Guiding Principles

- Optimize ridership levels
- Enhance service quality and efficiency
- Ensure equity and seamless system connectivity
- Reduce negative impacts on complementary ADA paratransit services
- Effectively manage transit resources and passenger amenities
- Maintain safety and transit security



Public Hearing Requirements

- Implementation of New Services
- Major Route Alterations
- Greater than 25% Change in Daily Number of Trips
- Non-Emergency Discontinuation of Service
- Fare Changes
